## Multiplication War

## Rules

1. 2-4 players at a time
2. Each person has their own baggie of cards.
3. You may use a multiplication chart.
4. Each person puts their cards face down in a pile in front of them.
5. At the same time, all players draw 2 cards and multiply them.
6. Players compare products to determine who has the highest product.
7. The player with the highest product takes ALL of the cards from the round.
8. Play continues until only 1 player has cards or until time runs out. If time runs out, each player counts how many cards they have. The person with the most cards WINS!
9. Put all the cards back into the baggies when you're done.


This player has $3 \times 12=36$ points.

This player has $10 \times 4=48$ points.
$36<48$, so the player with 48 points wins the round and gets to keep all of the cards.


This player has $3 \times 4=12$ points.


This player has $4 \times 2=8$ points.

This player has $6 \times 2=12$ points.

## What if 2 players have the same product?

 $8<12$, so the player with 8 points is out for this round. The other 2 players draw 2 more cards.This player has $3 \times 4=12$ points.


This player has $7 \times 6=42$ points.

42>40, so the player with 42 points wins the round and keeps ALL of the cards played for that round.

This player has $6 \times 2=12$ points.


This player has $8 \times 5=40$ points.

Remember, play continues until only 1 player has cards or until time runs out. If time runs out, each player counts how many cards they have. The person with the most cards WINS!

Return all cards to their baggies.
