A Multiplication Game

- For 2 Players
- Player 1 draws 2 cards and multiplies them together. Player 1 then tells Player 2 the product.
- Player 2 guesses the two factors that were multiplied to equal the product.
- If Player 2 guessed the correct 2 factors, s/he gets the 2 cards.

For 2 Players


- If Player 2 does not guess the correct 2 factors, s/he tries again, continuing to guess until the correct 2 factors are guessed. Player 2 does not get to keep the 2 cards unless s/he guessed correctly the first time.
- Once the factors are guessed, it is Player 2's turn to draw to cards and Player 1's turn to guess the factors.

For 3 Players


• If there are 3 players, Player 1 draws 2 cards while Players 2 and 3 take turns guessing the factors, Player 2 guessing first. Once the factors are guessed, it is Player 2's turn to draw 2 cards. Player 3 guesses first, followed by Player 1. When the factors are guessed, Player 3 draws with Player 1 guessing first, followed by Player 2.







